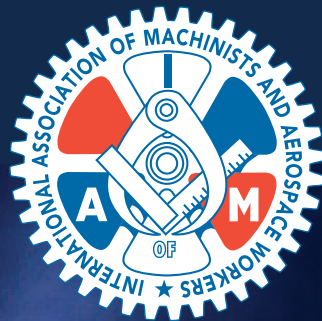


How Congress Voted *in the* 117th Congress

January 3, 2021 - July 31, 2022

LEGISLATIVE REPORT CARD



INTRODUCTION

This voting record shows where your federal lawmakers stand on important issues that impact working families, including workplace protections, voting rights, government agency funding, and more.

We've included the voting record for 10 IAM-supported bills that were voted in the U.S. House of Representatives during this 117th Congress, which convened on January 3, 2021. We've also included four IAM-supported bills that had a floor vote in the Senate, as well as the chamber's votes to confirm nominees for top labor-related posts in the Biden administration.

Methodology

The scores are calculated based on each lawmaker's vote on individual legislation that the Machinists Union supports.

Vote Details

U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

H.R. 1 - For The People Act of 2021

Final passage of legislation that would stop states from restricting a voter's access to the ballot box and curb the role of money in politics. This includes making it easier to vote by eliminating suppression obstacles and removing the influence money has gained in the political system.

The legislation was passed in the House by a 220 - 210 vote on March 3, 2021. The legislation has not passed the Senate.

THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 4 - John R. Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act of 2021

Final passage of legislation that would reverse a 2013 U.S. Supreme Court decision that struck down key portions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965.

The legislation passed the House by a 219-212 vote on August 24, 2021. The legislation has not passed the Senate.

THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 447 - National Apprenticeship Act of 2021

Final passage of legislation that would expand access to Registered Apprenticeships, youth apprenticeships and pre-apprenticeship programs. It would also yield a projected \$10.6 billion in net benefits to U.S. taxpayers in the form of increased tax revenue and decreased spending on public-assistance programs and unemployment insurance.

The legislation passed the House by a 247-173 vote on February 5, 2021. The legislation has not passed the Senate.

THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 842 - Richard L. Trumka Protecting the Right to Organize (PRO) Act of 2021

Final passage of legislation that would amend the National Labor Relations Act (NLRA) to broaden workers' rights to strike and unionize. That includes provisions such as removal of so-called right-to-work laws, and adding card check for union representation. Other details include penalties on predatory corporations that violate workers' rights, and combat misclassification of workers as supervisors and independent contractors.

The legislation passed the House by a 225-206 on March 9, 2021. The Senate has not passed the legislation.

THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 1319 - American Rescue Plan Act of 2021

Final passage of the massive rescue package that would provide much-needed relief for American workers impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. This ambitious legislative package included direct payments to workers as well as extend the the airline Payroll Support Program (PSP) to stave off layoffs. This included payroll support for airlines, Amtrak and transit rail and aerospace manufacturing. The bill also included the historic legislation known as the Butch Lewis Act to preserve and protect the multiemployer pension system.

The legislation passed the House by a 220-211 vote on March 10, 2021. The legislation passed the Senate and was signed into law by President Biden on March 11, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 3684 - Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act

Final passage of legislation, better known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Deal, that would repair and rebuild our roads and bridges, and improve transportation options through the largest investment in public transit in U.S. history. This legislation, which creates hundreds of thousands of high-quality jobs, is the largest investment in passenger rail since the creation of Amtrak.

The legislation passed the House by a 228-206 vote on July 10, 2021. The legislation passed the Senate and was signed into law by President Biden on November 15, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

S. 1605 - National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2022

Passage of legislation for authorizing funding for Defense spending for the fiscal year 2022. This includes manufacturing maintenance and overhaul of Defense Aerospace, as well as shipbuilding, space program and ammunition programs.

The legislation passed the House by a 363-70 vote on December 7. The legislation passed the Senate and was signed into law by President Biden on December 27, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 4502 - Labor, Health and Human Services, Education, Agriculture, Rural Development, Energy and Water Development, Financial Services and General Government, Interior, Environment, Military Construction, Veterans Affairs, Transportation, and Housing and Urban Development Appropriations Act, 2022

Passage of legislation setting appropriations of several federal agencies, including the U.S. Department of Labor and the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) for the 2022 fiscal year.

The legislation passed the House by a 219-208 vote on July 29, 2021. The legislation has not passed the Senate as of publication date of this scorecard. (Labor-HHS funding maintains previous levels through a chamber-passed continuing resolution)

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 5376 - Build Back Better Act

Final passage of the massive bill that would support working families by lowering health care costs, lowering child and family care costs, as well as invest billions of dollars in workforce development programs and public health infrastructure.

The legislation passed the House by a 220-213 vote on November 19, 2021. The legislation has not passed the Senate.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 4346 - CHIPS Act

Passage of legislation that includes \$52 billion in direct spending aimed at bolstering domestic semiconductor manufacturing incentive programs, among other provisions designed to boost U.S. innovation and competition against China.

The Senate-passed legislation passed the House in a 243-187 floor vote on July 28, 2022 and was signed into law by President Biden on August 9, 2022.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTS THIS LEGISLATION

Vote Details

U.S. SENATE

H.R. 1319 - American Rescue Plan Act of 2021

Final passage of the massive rescue package that would provide much-needed relief for American workers impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. This ambitious legislative package included direct payments to workers as well as extend the the airline Payroll Support Program (PSP) to stave off layoffs. This included payroll support for airlines, Amtrak and transit rail and aerospace manufacturing. The bill also included the historic legislation known as the Butch Lewis Act to preserve and protect the multiemployer pension system.

The House-passed legislation passed the Senate by a 50-49 vote on March 6, 2021. The legislation was signed into law by President Biden.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THIS LEGISLATION

H.R. 3684 - Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act

Final passage of legislation, better known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Deal, that would repair and rebuild our roads and bridges, and improve transportation options through the largest investment in public transit in U.S. history. This legislation, which creates hundreds of thousands of high-quality jobs, is also the largest investment in passenger rail since the creation of Amtrak.

The House-passed legislation passed the Senate by a 69-30 vote on July 10, 2021. The legislation was signed into law by President Biden on November 15, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THIS LEGISLATION

S. 1605 - National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2022

Passage of legislation for authorizing funding for Defense spending for the fiscal year 2022. This includes manufacturing maintenance and overhaul of Defense Aerospace, as well as shipbuilding, space program and ammunition programs.

The House-passed legislation passed the Senate by a 88-11 vote on Dec. 15. The legislation was signed into law by President Biden on December 27, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THIS LEGISLATION

PN-78-23 Confirmation of Marty Walsh as Labor Secretary

Final floor vote to confirm union member and former Boston Mayor Marty Walsh to be the 29th U.S. Secretary of Labor.

Mr. Walsh was confirmed by a 68-29 floor vote on March 22, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THE NOMINATION

PN-126 Confirmation of Jennifer Abruzzo for General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board

Final floor vote to confirm Jennifer Abruzzo to serve as general counsel of the NLRB.

Ms. Abruzzo was confirmed by a 51-50 floor vote on July 21, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THE NOMINATION

PN-609 Confirmation of Gwynne Wilcox to the National Labor Relations Board

Final floor vote to confirm Gwynne Wilcox to serve as a member of the NLRB.

Ms. Wilcox was confirmed by a 52-47 floor vote on July 28, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THE NOMINATION

PN-739 Confirmation of David Prouty to the National Labor Relations Board

Final floor vote to confirm David Prouty to serve as a member of the NLRB.

Mr. Prouty was confirmed by a 53-46 floor vote on July 29, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THE NOMINATION

PN-450 Confirmation of Deirdre Hamilton to the NMB

Final floor vote to confirm labor lawyer and former IAM legal fellow Dierdre Hamilton to serve as a member of the National Mediation Board, which handles rail disputes.

Ms. Hamilton was confirmed by a 52-48 floor vote on December 7, 2021.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THE NOMINATION

PN-1526 Confirmation of Owen E. Herrnstadt to the Export-Import Bank

Final floor vote to confirm foreign trade expert and former IAM chief of staff Owen E. Herrnstadt to serve as a member of the Export-Import Bank, which promotes job creation and prosperity.

Mr. Herrnstadt was confirmed by a 51-44 floor vote on July 13, 2022.

✔ THE IAM SUPPORTED THE NOMINATION

H.R. 4346 - CHIPS Act

Passage of legislation that includes \$52 billion in direct spending aimed at bolstering domestic semiconductor manufacturing incentive programs, among other provisions designed to boost U.S. innovation and competition against China.

The Senate passed the legislation in a 64-33 vote on July 27, 2022. The legislation passed the House, and was signed into law by President Biden.

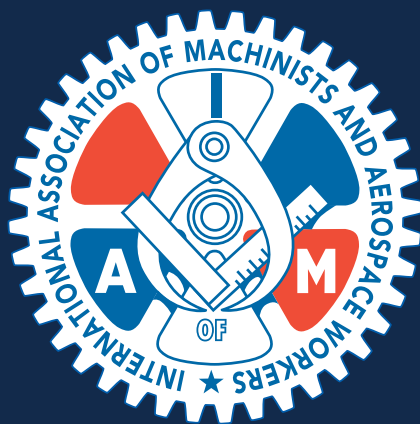
